Black Education Matters Scholarship Application

Recipients of the Black Education Matters Scholarship will receive scholarship funds to cover tuition and in-course supplemental materials for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (Pre-Licensure) program. The out of pocket costs and additional text books are the students own financial responsibility. For these costs, recipients are welcome to apply for Financial Aid or utilize the installment payment plan.

To continue eligibility, recipients must maintain a 3.25 GPA each term throughout the program. Additionally, you will need to maintain continuous enrollment with no breaks greater than 30 days.

Scholarship awards may be taxable; please contact your tax professional for further advice.

I understand that if I withdraw from the program, or do not meet the eligibility criteria in a term, all remaining scholarship disbursements will be forfeited.

I understand part of the requirements for this scholarship application is that the student must self-identify as black, indigenous, person of color.
