However, the institution can enroll for all programs, with the exception of the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (Pre-Licensure) ("BSNPL")* program, while the state authorization application is in process. Currently enrolled students are approved to continue their program.
Alaska	Exempt	All programs are exempt from authorization with the exception of the BSNPL program which is not approved. The institution is exempt from authorization provisions of AS 14.48 per regulation 20 AAC 17.015(a)(8).
Arizona	Licensed	AZPPSE granted a regular accredited vocational and degree program license for Aspen programs. Aspen is not accepting BSNPL students in Arizona at this time.

### Bachelor of Science in Nursing (Pre-Licensure) Notices

\*Aspen's Bachelor of Science in Nursing (Pre-Licensure) program is the only program offered by Aspen that has the potential to allow graduates to apply for professional licensure in the following states: Arizona, Florida, Georgia, Texas and Tennessee. Upon completion of their studies in this program, students are eligible to take the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX) in the state in which they choose to practice (the NCLEX is the national registered nurse examination used by all states for potential registered nursing licensure) and submit an application for licensure. Students provide their state board of nursing applicable forms to the School of Nursing and Health Sciences, which completes them on behalf of the individual student, and take the exam in the state in which they choose to practice. Upon passing the NCLEX, students then work with their state Board of Nursing to secure their professional licensure, including requirements beyond educational background and NCLEX passage.

**Aspen is enrolling new students in the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (Pre-licensure) program in Texas, Florida, Tennessee, and Georgia only.**

### Licensure/Certification Disclosures
