Students who relocate while enrolled in a degree program may be unable to complete their studies if they are moving to a country or state where the University is not currently authorized to offer that particular program. ### Bachelor of Science in Nursing (Pre-Licensure) Notices

\* Aspen is not enrolling new students in the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (Pre-licensure) program. The program is in teach-out for currently enrolled students in all locations.

Aspen's Bachelor of Science in Nursing (Pre-Licensure) program is the only program offered by Aspen that has the potential to allow graduates to apply for professional licensure. Upon completion of their studies in this program, students are eligible to take the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX) in the state in which they choose to practice (the NCLEX is the national registered nurse examination used by all states for potential registered nursing licensure) and submit an application for licensure. Students provide their state board of nursing applicable forms to the School of Nursing and Health Sciences, which completes them on behalf of the individual student, and take the exam in the state in which they choose to practice. Upon passing the NCLEX, students then work with their state Board of Nursing to secure their professional licensure, including requirements beyond educational background and NCLEX passage.

### Licensure/Certification Disclosures

Institutions are required to disclose the extent to which each of its programs lead to professional licensure or certification in each state where such licensure is required for employment in an occupation (34 CFR § 668.43(a)(5)(v)). The curriculum either meets state educational requirements for licensure or certification, does not meet state education requirements licensure or certification, or the institution has not made such a determination.
